





The audio system of a six-year-old BMW seems archaic, especially when compared to the Logic 7 digital audio system in the new BMW body style. The new BMWs also offer features such as auxiliary audio input (AUX), MP3 playback, and Sirius Satellite Radio. If you spend much time driving a car, you might wonder how you ever lived without these great features. Armed with the right information, you can correctly upgrade AUX, MP3, and Sirius support in your older BMW and have it operate exactly as it would in a new BMW.

To demonstrate these technology upgrades, we will focus on a 2001 5 Series E39 with navigation. The 2001 model was selected because it was manufactured just prior to when BMW switched from the Alpine trunk-mounted navigation radio to the Becker version, which has a slightly different radio connector. Despite this difference, it is still quite simple to retrofit a 2001 E39 with AUX, MP3 support, and BMW Sirius Satellite Radio. Initially, it requires upgrading the trunk-mounted radio for the AUX and Sirius Satellite support as well as upgrading the trunk-mounted navigation computer to the DVD MKIV for proper display of the MP3 and Sirius audio text on the navigation screen.

You can address the connector difference between the older Alpine and newer Becker radio by purchasing adapter harnesses from your BMW dealer. There are a few tricks for getting the wiring correct that are detailed on www. bimmernav.com/sirius.html, but overall, it is a simple and quick task in the E39. The navigation radio model year is the crucial component, with the newer radios supporting the most features. Look for a 2006 X5 or E46 replacement radio for the most features. Once you upgrade the radio, you can easily add the other components to your E39 just by plugging them in. Now that your radio has additional modes, displaying this information properly requires upgrading the navigation computer.

Upgrading the navigation comptuer is a simple plug and play. In the 2001 E39 equipped with the CD navigation computer, you can simply remove the older and slower CD-based system and replace it with the newer and faster DVD-based MKIV navigation computer. Upgrading the navigation computer provides you with a new 3D Map viewing, DVD map of all US and Canada, and it will also display the information on your navigation screen correctly for Sirius, MP3, and AUX.

Starting in 2006, BMW introduced a new CD changer that plays MP3s and can support MP3 ID3 Audiotext on the navigation display. Upgrading to the new CD changer with MP3 support is a simple plug and play. The CD Changer will play MP3s correctly using the old radio and navigation computer, but in order to display ID3 Audiotext, you need the upgraded radio and nav components.







Dreams Can Come True...

...a new set of race tracks within 3 hours of NYC

The dream of a new racing complex in New Jersey was the topic of anticipation for years in the tri-state area. Speculation of new racetrack openings is the stuff of Internet fodder.

Thread after thread popped up on various Internet forums about this new track complex being built halfway between Atlantic City and Philadelphia. I saw the threads, looked at the maps and read the background on this place. I was instantly intrigued. For a certified track junkie, this is like finding a new dealer living around

the block. As of July 4th 2008, the New Jersey Motorsports Park, including Thunderbolt Raceway and the Lightning Circiut, has become a reality.


Our buddies to the west, a.k.a. the New Jersey and Delaware Valley BMW CCA Chapters, hosted a High Performance Driver's School at the newly opened facility this past August. Back in March when I learned of this, I instantly registered for their 3-day event.

Speculation of new racetrack openings is the stuff of Internet fodder.

What can I say about Thunderbolt Raceway? This amazing track is the brainchild of the founders of Virginia International Raceway (VIR). For starters, it blows away any configuration at Pocono. Being longer than Lime Rock or BeaveRun coupled with 14 turns, it is a jam-packed track. It may never be compared to Watkins Glen, but it does have some distinct advantages over all the other tracks in the Northeast. I could ramble on about how Turn 2 on Thunderbolt is a sweet blind cresting turn, or how the track provides enough technical turns to ensure years of thrills, but I'll save you the bench racing and direct you to your nearest computer to witness a hot lap.

Go to youtube.com and search NJMP Thunderbolt BMWCCA.

One of the worst aspects of visiting some tracks is the surrounding infrastructure and local population. Samples of the horrors of track towns can be no-name cheap gas, bad food, expensive lodging and the lack of a Big Box or auto parts store for those last minute needs. In addition, sneers and bad looks from the

local Jim-Bobs in their pickups can put you on edge when you're in some of these one-horse towns. Just try asking the attendant to

expect the park's impact to be transformational. Here's a quote from Millville Vice Mayor Joe Derella: "The New Jersey

hurry up and turn on the gas pump so you can make grid call at Summit Point in West Virginia.

NJMP is in Millville, New Jersey, which has it all. The main road has convenient fast food places, as well as a number of good restaurants. Did somebody say steak? There's an Advanced Auto Parts and a couple clean, name brand gas stations pumping 93-octane fuel. The biggest thing I found was the locals were happy to see us. "You guys here for the track?" was a common question from the

townsfolk. Then they'd smile and give us a discount or occasionally a "thank you"! Holy Twilight Zone Batman, friendly locals?! This undoubtedly adds to the enjoyment of this new venue.

Millville officials, who have been struggling to reinvent the depressed city, once driven by glass factories and lumber mills,

The biggest thing I found was the locals were *happy* to see us. "You guys here for the track?"... Motorsports Park project will bring a positive social economic impact on the city and the entire region. A recent economic impact study produced by Rowan University predicted NJMP will generate more than 6,000 jobs and also have a \$200+ million economic impact throughout Cumberland County within five years."


