What is an autocross?

Autocross is a friendly competitive event that involves the sport of trying to navigate your street car through a course, marked with cones, faster than other drivers. Autocrossing is not wheel-to-wheel racing and only one or sometimes two cars (staggered by a half lap) are allowed on the course at a given time. The laps are timed and a typical run will last less than two minutes

If you ever wanted to see just how well your BMW can accelerate, brake, and corner in a safe controlled environment, you must attend a NY Chapter autocross. Yes, it is legal. No, you won't get a traffic violation. You will get a chance to meet other BMW club members and see their cars.

2001 BMW CCA NY Chapter Summerfest at Habberstad BMW

Once again Habberstad BMW hosted the annual Summerfest event and invited all chapter members to their dealership. Over 200 members attended the annual event at Habberstad BMW in Hungtington, Long Island on Sunday, July 29th, 2001. Almost all examples of BMW's extensive model offering were on display. The parking lot was full with club member BMWs of every vintage. Some club members trailered their race cars and displayed them at the event.

Our featured speaker was Tom Salkowsky, BMW NorthAmerica ///M Brand Manager. . Tom is in charge of all M cars in the USA and is also the liaison for BMW sponsored racing teams in the USA. He gave a presentation on BMW's racing programs, focusing on American LeMans Series (ALMS) and the Formula 1 (F1) program.

Other featured speakers in-

cluded Fred Pignitaro and Alfred DuPont. Both race Habberstad BMW sponsored race cars in the Speedvision World Challenge Series. Checkout http://www.speedvision.com for more info.

Tom hurried down to Habberstad BMW, in a new E46 M3 convertible, after watching live coverage of the Formula 1 race at Hockenheim Ring in Germany. He was glad to report that Williams BMW won the German Grand Prix when Ralf took the top spot at Hockenheim.

Tom spoke about BMW racing programs and involvement in the American Lemans and Formula 1 series. The presentation included a lot of information about future ///M cars. Tom explained how BMW's race car development is tied very closely with BMW product development for street cars. A perfect example is the introduction of Formula 1 style gearshifting with paddles mounted behind the steering wheel (SMG – Sequential Manual Gearshift) now offered







on the new M3.

Tom brought some interesting video footage of BMW race cars. The Q and A session with Tom lasted over 1 hour. Chapter members asked every imaginable question about current and future cars. Tom confirmed in the session that BMW will not be making an E46 4Dr M3 and the V8 powered M3 will not debut in the USA.

Finally Tom raffled off 2001 Formula 1 hats and a piston and connecting rod from a BMW powered PTG race car.

Habberstad opened all areas of the completely renovated facility to us. They had special discounts on parts and Dinan upgrades with free labor. A Dinan cold-air intake upgrade was demonstrated in the workshop. Habberstad raffled off countless BMW life-style products and raised money for the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation.

Lunch was provided by Habberstad BMW for everyone. Lunch included sandwiches, salad, pizza, water and soda.

I'd like to invite all our members, family and friends to attend the Great Margues at Old Westbury Gardens Concour D'Elegance. This is the premier event of the year for the New York Chapter. This year the event is being held on Sunday September 16th (raindate, September 23th). The location is Old Westbury Gardens, in Old Westbury, NY. Directions can be found at the at the Visitor's Info link on the left side of the followweb http:// ing page www.oldwestburygardens.org/ mainmenu.html or elsewhere in this newsletter with the application for the concour. Gates will open at 9AM sharp.

We can expect to see some beautiful and exotic foreign automobiles. Last year we had over one thousand people attend the Concour, viewing over 65 automobiles that were being exhibited. The grounds at the Gardens are also beautiful and exotic. It will be truly difficult to find enough time to enjoy both these fine automobiles and the beautiful gardens.

Many members are concerned about showing their cars, and would like to know how they will be judged. There will be a Street Class and a Concour Class. The Street class is for people like you and me. We drive our cars on a daily basis, sometimes we might even do an autocross or a track event. BUT, we do keep our cars clean! If you enter street class, you will be judged only on the exterior of the car. There are 100 points obtainable.

The breakdown in judging goes as follows:

Body Condition	30 points
Paint	15 points
Trim	15 points
Wheels and Tires	30 points
(outer surface)	
Glass	10 points

Okay, so there might be a few of you "Q-tippers" out there, with your "garage queens". Well, you already know that the 16th of September will be your day to show off your pride and joy. I know, you know, all about Concours, but just a little info for the rest of us mere mortals. A concour class car will be judged on the basis of 200 points (I told you these cars are something special, didn't I?) They are being judged on both exterior as well as interior. The following is the breakdown on scoring for this class:
